## **MSVC-MOAA Made a Good Impression at the YARS Air Show**





### **Directions from Canfield**

- 1. In Canfield. Start out going west on E, Main St./US-224 toward N. Broad St./US-62/OH-46.
- 2. Take the 1st left onto S Broad St./US-62/OH-46.
- 3. Take 1<sup>st</sup> right onto Lisbon St/US 62, follow US-62.
- 4. Turn RIGHT onto US-62. Bear LEFT US-62 towards Salem. (Landmark—pass by White House Fruit Farms )
- 5. Keep going STRAIGHT towards Salem. DO NOT turn right on the Bypass 62. Follow Route 9 (N. Lincoln Ave.) STRAIGHT ahead into Salem.
- 6. Continue on N. Lincoln Ave. to State St. intersection (landmarks Family Video and Home Bank) and continue STRAIGHT ahead to next traffic light which is the intersection of S. Lincoln Ave. & E. Pershing St.
- 7. Turn LEFT onto E. Pershing Street.
- 8. Watch for park entrance on the right(5–6 blocks) circle area Pavilion #3 is on the left as you enter

For those using a GPS— Put in 1511 E. Pershing, Salem, Ohio 44460. That should get you to Centennial Park.
