# MSVC October Meeting – VSC Director Mercer County – Recognition of Vietnam War Era Veterans

The MSVC-MOAA held its annual Business Meeting and election of officers on Friday, October 25th, at the Consolidated Activities Center of the Youngstown Air Reserve Station in Vienna.

A near record of over 50 members and guests in attendance listened to LTC Larry Scheetz introduce his replacement, Bradley Alan, as the new Director of Veterans Affairs in Mercer County. Scheetz, a Desert Storm veteran, had served as Director in Mercer County for the past several years since his retirement from the Army Reserves. Guest Speaker Brad Alan, is serving in the Marine Corps Reserves, Marine and Family Division, Marine For Life Network, Greater Pittsburgh Region was the guest speaker at the luncheon business meeting. Alan remains in the reserves where he serves as a Marine For Life Network representative helping recently discharged veterans to transition back into civilian life. The services the Mercer County Veterans Affairs office provides include assistance with disability compensation claims, pension claims, real estate tax exemption for 100% permanently and totally disabled veterans, emergency financial assistance, applications for VA home loan certificate of eligibil-

ity, applications for VA healthcare, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) counseling, and recording or requesting military discharge papers and death gratuity benefits.

The annual business meeting of the Chapter was conducted with a presentation of a two-page summary of each of the Executive Officers major accomplishments and duties over the past year as well as reports submitted by the various sub-committees of the Chapter. These included Legislative Affairs, Public Relations, Student Affairs (ROTC/Junior Lawrence County: Brad Alan, Mark ROTC), Surviving Spouse Representative, Newsletter Editor, the Board Members at Large. The slate of Officers and Board Members who were nominated and accepted at last month's meeting were officially and duly elected to their respective positions by a unanimous vote of the members present. They will commence their term of office on January 1, 2020 and will be sworn in during the January meeting. - e. *Programs Committee*, should plan and execute a program of activities in consonance with the purposes of MSVC and the desires of the membership. It is vital that planned activities be varied and appeal to all members so they will want to participate and remain MSVC members.
- f. *Public Relations/Communications Committee*, oversees, newsletters, news releases for newspapers and the web page.
- g. Student Affairs Committee, arrange to present MOAA medal to ROTC and JROTC at local colleges and schools that have the program.
- h. Surviving Spouse Committee, as a point of contact for surviving spouse issues with MSVC counterparts; coordinate directly with national MOAA's Surviving Spouse Advisory Committee and provide information for dealing with questions or problems concerning surviving-spouse issues, to include legislation and benefits information.
- i. Roster and E-mail Point of Contact Committee, this committee will assist the secretary and membership committee by maintaining the electronic membership roster. Other responsibilities are email addresses and information distributed to the membership electronically.

In addition to Brad Alan, the Chapter invited Herman Breuer, the Director of the Trumbull County Veterans Service Commission, and Nate Walker, a Veteran Service Officer from the Mahoning County Veterans Service Commission to participate in presenting the official Vietnam Veterans Lapel Pin to qualifying Chapter members who served on Active Duty during the Vietnam War era. The purpose of the Lapel Pin, issued by the Department of Defense, is to recognize, thank, and honor United States military who served on Active Duty between November 1, 1955 to May 15, 1975, regardless of their service location. As directed by protocol, these pins are to be presented to each Vietnam veteran during public events held in their

communities by Commemorative Partners. The MSVC-MOAA became a Commemorative Partner on March 3, 2017. Of the 55 eligible Chapter members, 23 served in the country of Vietnam. It is estimated that 9 million veterans served during the Vietnam War era and that 7 million are still living and eligible to receive this recognition pin. Each Veteran Service Officer presented pins to their respective County constituents. Those who were not able to attend the presentation ceremony will be awarded the Lapel Pin at the next MSVC-MOAA luncheon meeting on Friday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> starting at Noon, CAC, YARS. Guest speaker will be Terri Ann Naughton, she is the Director of Psychological Health for the 910<sup>th</sup> Airlift Wing.
